

Hanover Primary School – Early Years Pupil Premium Expenditure 2015-16

Children come into our nursery class with a broad range of previous experience. Some have already attended day nurseries or other early years settings while others have not. Most children have had English spoken at home and some have been spoken to in another or other languages. Some have had the advantage of coming from families who have spent significant time with them on early reading and number facts where some come into our nursery without this experience. Some have had a lot of interaction with other children and others have not socialised very much outside of the immediate family group.

We recognise the value of early intervention in supporting children’s development and learning in all areas where, if barriers can be addressed in the early years, this can facilitate children’s success as they progress up the school.

We are using the £3,300 Early Years Pupil Premium 2015-16 to support the above in the following way:
